Happy New Year Everyone!

We sincerely hope that this finds you and all those close to you well. We are happy to be able to share the news that Apollo Park continues to be fully operational every week and ready to safely accommodate our owners and guests.

Currently, the front desk remains closed and check-in procedures are contactless by using the lockbox. Our staff is well and continues to do their work on site. Owners or guests may reach them in the office by phone or e mail. This process has worked well, and we will monitor the need for change as we go forward.

A change in housekeeping - you may now choose what level of services you prefer during your stay. No one will enter your condo after you arrive unless you authorize Tuesday housekeeping services. Be sure to check your options and preferences on the schedule next to the lock box when you arrive. Cleaning methods continue to include weekly deep cleaning to ensure everything is ready for your arrival.

As most of you probably know, Vail Resorts is limiting the number of skiers on the mountain every day to 50% of capacity. Reservations are required and can be made at vail.com. There are various restrictions at most ski areas in the state, you should check the websites before going to any ski area.

Please visit our website at apollopark.net to check all things Apollo Park as well as news about Eagle County. The site is updated as necessary and now includes even more information. Answers to Frequently Asked Questions, a listing of units for resale, the weekly check-in calendar, a gallery of pictures and more are always available. When planning your trip to Vail, check vail.com - 'Explore the Resort' for current information regarding activities and events happening during your stay.

Mountain View Phase 2 construction continues, but they are no longer using our parking lot for staging or parking. They do have an agreement for very limited use mid-week, but a flagger will safely direct vehicles when they are on the Apollo lot.
